A vacancy exist for the position of **Fitter – Mechanical, Engineering Division**.

The successful candidate will work under the supervisor of the Section Leader – Mechanical or his designate.

Duties and Responsibilities

- ❖ Removing and installing pumps and mechanical equipment at the Wastewater Treatment Plant or Potable Water Treatment Facility;
- ❖ Servicing and repairing of mechanical motors and pumps including testing before re-installing;
- ❖ Trouble shooting and conducting inspections of mechanical equipment to ensure proper operation;
- ❖ Recording work activities on worksheets;
- ❖ Any other related duties as assigned by the Section Leader – Mechanical of his designate.

Educational Requirements

- ❖ A two (2) year technical diploma or Associate Degree in Mechanical Engineering;
- ❖ Three (3) years' experience performing the above duties.

Knowledge and Skills

- ❖ Excellent technical knowledge of the principles of mechanics and equipment operations to inspect, service and repair a variety of equipment essential to the effective and efficient operation of mechanical systems;
- ❖ Excellent knowledge of testing, repair and preventative maintenance procedures and tools and materials required;
- ❖ Good computer literacy (e.g. competency in Microsoft Word and Excel);
- ❖ Good written and verbal communication skills to document equipment problems, order supplies and discuss maintenance issues with Supervisor;
- ❖ Good observation skills to identify causes of equipment malfunction;
- ❖ Requires six (6) to nine (9) months on-the-job experience upon completion of technical training to demonstrate job competence; and
